Please ask at Reception for a form to complete if you have recently changed your address or phone number, mobile or landline, to ensure that you do not miss text message reminders sent out for all appointments.

Missed Appointments

If you can't attend your booked appointment, please let us know as soon as possible. The best way is by using the confirmation text or the reminder text which you get before your appointment.

Alternatively, you can call us or use one of the on-line apps. In June 2025 we had 126 appointments that were not used. **Your appointment could go to someone who really needs it.**

Bowel Cancer Screening

The Bowel Cancer Screening Kit can save your life! If you are sent a kit, we encourage patients to take part in this screening programme.

Just a tiny sample detects signs of cancer before you notice anything is wrong.

If you are between the ages of 50 and 74 you will automatically be invited to do a test. If you are 75 or over you will not be invited but you are able to request a screening kit by phoning 0800 707 6060 every two years.

Children's immunisations

These are administered as part of the child's vaccination schedule at 8 weeks, 12 weeks, 16 weeks, 12 months and 3 years 4 months.

They protect against Polio, Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Meningococcal B, Meningococcal C, Pneumococcal, Hep B, HiB, Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Rotavirus.

Update on Tirzepatide for weight management

Weight management services are locally commissioned at an Integrated Care Board (ICB) level. In mid and south Essex, access to Tirzepatide (Mounjaro®) will initially be through specialist weight management services only.

Access to Tirzepatide through Primary Care Networks is not expected to start in mid and south Essex until later in 2025.

Antibiotics – What you need to know

Antibiotics do not treat infections that are caused by a virus, such as colds, most coughs, sore throats, ear infections, diarrhoea, cystitis or flu.

They do treat serious infections caused by bacteria, such as pneumonia, urinary tract infections, sexually transmitted infections, meningitis and sepsis.

Test Results

If you are waiting for test results, you can see them online, either by using the NHS App or systmonline.

If you would like access to systmonline you will need to register with the surgery, when you will need to produce some form of ID.

You do not need to contact the surgery to download the NHS app – we are notified electronically and approve it from our system.

Blood Pressure Monitoring

If you are sent a message from the practice asking for an up-to-date BP reading, please reply to the message with a reading from home.

Patient Participation Group (PPG)

Bus Routes to local hospitals

To Queens Red bus 498 outside Wetherspoons

To Basildon No.9 (operated by FirstBus) from opposite Wetherspoons to Basildon Bus Station; then bus B2 to the Hospital

To Broomfield Shuttle bus from the Chelmer Valley Park and Ride site on Essex Regiment Way. The minibus shuttle runs every 30 minutes from 06:30am to 19.30pm Monday to Friday from the bus stop opposite the terminus building.

Be Sun Prepared!!

Remember that prevention is better than cure. Always use sun cream and apply frequently, especially after being in water.
